| A hazard is something that may cause harm or damage. This is a great place to add comments which will be used as part of the review. |
| Behaviour - Risk of over excitement | All Present | Everyone to follow section code of conduct that sets clear expectations and behaviour standards. | |
| Emergency aid | All Present | A qualified first aider will be present throughout the activity. A first aid kit will be on site during the activity. | |
| Reluctance to be involved | YP | If any Young Person does not wish to take part, this is fine. They will likely not come along to the evening, but if there is a change of mind on the night, these YP can stay sit out in the viewing area with a leader. | |
