The Scout leaders are in no position to 'second-guess' any of these risks. Therefore, the below risks are general Scouting ones only and not related to the tour specifically.

What hazard have you identified? What are the risks from it?	Who is at risk?	How are the risks already controlled? What extra controls are needed?	What has changed that needs to be thought about and controlled?
A hazard is something that may cause harm or damage. The risk is the harm that may occur from the hazard.	For example: young people, adult volunteers, visitors	Controls are ways of making the activity safer by removing or reducing the risk. For example, you may use a different piece of equipment or you might change the way you do the activity.	Keep checking throughout the activity in case you need to change what you're doing or even stop the activity. This is a great place to add comments which will be used as part of the review.
Behaviour - Risk of over excitement	All Present	Everyone to follow section code of conduct that sets clear expectations and behaviour standards.	
Emergency aid	All Present	A qualified first aider will be present throughout the activity. A first aid kit will be on site during the activity.	
Reluctance to be involved	YP	If any Young Person does not wish to take part, this is fine. They will likely not come along to the evening, but if there is a change of mind on the night, these YP can stay behind in the visitor centre/café area, and be accompanied by their parent, or a leader.
